The Forensic Fraud Accountant under the direction of the Deputy Chief Investigator and the Division Manager of the Economic Crime Division, will support assigned Investigator/Attorney teams in the analysis of financial data and extracts and define relevant information. The person chosen for this assignment will gain valuable experience in how the criminal justice system operates and will be working with various databases and search engines. Our Forensic Fraud Accountant will review case files, interpret financial records and provide result analysis for the purpose of analyzing the financial probability of criminal activity. Our Forensic Fraud Accountant will as interpret financial transactions and events for users to support effective decision making regarding filing possible criminal charges. This individual will use various software applications, such as spreadsheets, relational databases, statistical packages, and graphics packages to assemble, manipulate and/or format data and/or reports. Our Forensic Fraud Accountant may also be required to act as an advisory witness for the prosecutor during court hearings.
